- Slight right onto the ramp to Hwy 101 N/US-101 N/Olympic Hwy

- Turn right onto the Washington 3 N ramp to Olympic Peninsula
- Merge onto WA-3 N
- Turn left onto State Route 104 W/WA-104 W/Hood Canal Bridge
- Continue to follow State Route 104 W/WA-104 W (15 mi)
- Slight right onto the ramp to Hwy 101 N/US-101 N/Olympic Hwy

- Turn right onto Dayton St
- Take the 1st left onto Ferry Terminal Ln11
- Take the State Route 104 W/WA-104 W/Edmonds Kingston Ferry to Kingston
- Continue straight onto State Route 104 W/WA-104 W
- Turn right to stay on State Route 104 W/WA-104 W
- Turn right onto State Route 104 W/WA-104 W/Hood Canal Bridge
- Continue to follow State Route 104 W/WA-104 W (go 15 mi)
- Slight right onto the ramp to Hwy 101 N/US-101 N/Olympic Hwy
